



AFSPAB and NFIA working to improve our Industry

Overview

The NFIA and AFSPAB have been working together to enhance the current AFSPAB Scheme.

We are informed by AFSPAB that they are currently wrapping-up, and the NFIA – AFSPAB Scheme will be in a position to formally endorse successful applicants once this has been completed. We anticipate that this will occur mid-March 2022.

The NFIA will administer the Scheme moving forward and will work with Industry professionals to continue to improve our Industry. Going forward, the NFIA will be your point of contact for AFSPAB-related matters, under the NFIA – AFSPAB Scheme.

What happens to current AFSPAB Practitioners?

The NFIA – AFSPAB Scheme will continue to recognise Practitioners currently-endorsed by AFSPAB until at least 1 November 2022. A process for renewals beyond November 2022 is currently being developed. You will receive updates as this progresses.

Insurance

There are no changes to insurance requirements. Professionals remain responsible for maintaining their own insurance.

What are the fees for accreditation?

We are working hard to keep fees cost-effective. The application fees payable will be:

- \$550.00 for a single endorsement category; and
- \$150.00 for each additional endorsement category.

These fees are inclusive of GST and will remain unchanged until further notice.



What will be the ongoing renewal fees?

The renewal fee payable will be \$550.00 per person (not per category). This fee is inclusive of GST and will remain unchanged until further notice.

As per current arrangements, membership renewals will occur on a 12-monthly basis.
